YEAR 2 SCHOOL SWIMMING AND WATER SAFETY PROGRAM

Dear Parent/Carers,

Arrangements have been made to include a Learn to Swim Program in our school curriculum. All Year 2 students are expected to participate in this program. The Department of Education and Training's School Swimming and Water Safety Program is an intensive learn-to-swim program that develops water confidence and provides students with basic skills in water safety and survival. Students will pay daily pool entry costs. There is no charge for the program. The program is conducted over ten days. Each daily lesson is 45 minutes.

- Date:** Monday, 15 September 2025 to Friday, 26 September 2025
- Depart School:** Depart: 9:00am Return: 11:00am
- Where:** Bay & Basin Leisure Centre, The Wool Rd, Vincentia
- Transport:** Walk
- Cost:** \$38.00 (**Bay & Basin Learn to Swim Pool Membership is not accepted**) - **NO REFUNDS**
- Wear:** Students are to wear their school uniform and will change at school before departing for the Leisure Centre.
- What to bring:** Swimming costume, towel, school hat, goggles, water bottle, fruit break in a container, and a plastic bag for wet items.

Other Information:

The kiosk will be closed to participants. Students should bring wet-weather items such as a raincoat or rain poncho each day. In the event of extreme wet weather, a bus will be organised to transport the children.

We will also be requesting that students bring a complete spare set of clothes (underwear, socks, shirt, pants, and jumper) and a towel to be left at school for the duration of the program. These clothes do not need to be school uniform and should be in a labelled bag. This is to enable students to have a dry change of clothes if they get wet during the walk back to school. All items of clothing, including socks, need to be clearly labelled with your child's name.

Students can wear goggles during their lesson but during school swimming assessments for water safety skills, students will participate without goggles.
